Nancy Ryan will be teaching us her "Stripping an Abstract Quilt". We'll make a 12x12 sample square to learn the technique for this beautiful and easy design. Join us!

Supply list:

- 1. Sewing machine in good working order and special sewing feet for your machine. Also, a stitch that swings left and right to quilt your project
- 2. A table extension for your machine
- 3. All sewing supplies that you would use to sew a quilt: scissors, pins, ruler, rotary cutter, cutting mat, etc
- 4. Thread that you would like to use to quilt your piece
- 5. Heat and Bond Lite or Hot Fix Adhesive
- 6. **Fusible fleece** (used for batting)
- 7. A piece of fabric for the backside of your quilt (12x12 square)
- 8. Any other fabric embellishments that you would like to use to create your piece
- 9. Iron and ironing mat (** Guild will have several stations set up at the church)
- 10. Fabrics for creating two pieces of fabric that are embellished and then will be cut into strips. Two opposite color combinations work best for this technique!
- 11. A mat that you can pin into to hold strips when working on your design
- 12. Fabric Glue
